59th German Viticulture Congress

The German Winegrowers' Association (DWV) will stage the 59th German Viticulture Congress in Stuttgart during INTERVITIS INTERFRUCTA 2007.

A varied international Congress programme will be on offer at the Congress Centre in Killesberg from 21 to 26 April 2007. International scientists will present their latest research results. In addition to the talks, the conferences will be an ideal platform for speakers and delegates from all over the world to exchange experiences. The German Winegrowers' Association expects that more than 1,000 delegates from 20 countries will attend the different events. The Congress languages will be German, English and French.

8th International Symposium „Innovations in Enology“

This Symposium, which will be under the patronage of the OIV, will be held on 21 and 22 April 2007 and is being organised jointly by the German Winegrowers' Association and the Research Foundation of German Viticulture Winegrowers (FDW).

In around 25 talks scientists from 13 countries will present new techniques and methods, enological measures, quality optimisation and analysis methods. Over 100 proposals for papers were submitted, which made it difficult to make a selection. Some contributions will be presented as posters.

8th International Symposium „Technology in Viticulture“

The renowned Viticulture Symposium will also be under the patronage of the OIV in 2007 and is being organised jointly by the German Winegrowers' Association and the Commission for Technology in Viticulture (ATW) on 21 and 22 April 2007.

The number of paper proposals submitted from all over the world is a clear indication of the excellent reputation, which the Symposium enjoys in the international winegrowing industry. Around 25 speakers will present new techniques relating to maturity measurement, sustainable production methods and management of winegrowing on steep slopes. A separate poster presentation will be staged in addition to the talks.

2nd International Symposium „Organic Viticulture“

„Guidelines for Organic Enology“ is the title of the second edition of the successful international symposium „Organic Viticulture“. This event will be under the patronage of the OIV and is being organised jointly by the German Winegrowers' Association and ECOVIN.

On 24 April 2007 international speakers will talk about standards from different winegrowing countries, describe current research activities and present reports and practical experience from which guidelines for ecological viticulture can be derived. Other interesting contributions to this topic will be presented as posters.

„Global Climate Change – Consequences for Viticulture and Enology“

A joint section for „Innovations in Enology“ and „Technology in Viticulture“ will be staged for the first time in 2007.

The two Symposiums will be combined on the morning of 22 April 2007 under the title of „Global Climate Change - Consequences for Viticulture and Enology“. International speakers will be invited here to present the latest findings in this explosive field. The German Winegrowers' Association is delighted that OIV President Peter Hayes (Australia) has accepted the invitation to be the guest speaker on this topic. In addition to the conference languages of German, English and French, this joint section will also feature simultaneous interpreting in Chinese.

Workshop with a tour of the trade fair

In addition to the Congress, the delegates to the Symposiums will be able to enjoy a special highlight on 23 April 2007, i.e. an organised tour of the trade fair.

Selected exhibitors at INTERVITIS INTERFRUCTA 2007 will be visited in groups. These exhibitors will then give short talks on the technological implementation of innovations in enology and viticulture. Through their products, manufacturers form the interface between science and practice. The trade fair will also feature for the first time a separate presentation area containing the entries for the 2007 INTERVITIS INTERFRUCTA Innovation Award.

International Riesling Symposium 2007

The Federal Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Consumer Protection will stage an International Riesling Symposium for the first time on 23 April 2007.

Experts in the fields of viticulture, enology and marketing from all the world's most important winegrowing countries will be able to obtain information during the event and exchange experiences of trends in the cultivation and processing of Riesling, as well as market and marketing aspects.

International Conference „Wine-Tourism-Architecture“

During an „international“ tour of the trade fair, young winegrowers from Germany and neighbouring European countries will have an exclusive opportunity to visit the stands of exhibitors at INTERVITIS INTERFRUCTA 2007. During the „Young Winegrowers' Party“ in the evening, all the delegates will be able to forge contacts, form friendships and continue the day's discussions to the accompaniment of wine and music.
